August Meeting –August 5th

David Thornton will be the Mini-seminar speaker at 6 p.m. He will put his computer nerddom to use and discuss internet resources concerning the oil spill. He will also put his decades of pier fishing experience to use to discuss catch and release fishing from the Gulf State Park pier. Local inshore guide Capt. Dan Kolennich will be the main speaker. Joey Gates will give the Quickhits.

August “Mobile Bay Grandslam”-August 7th

The categories for the August tournament will be speckled trout, redfish, flounder, white trout and blackfish. There will also be an award for the angler that weighs in the biggest “Grandslam” of speckled trout, redfish and flounder. Also, five “bonus” tournament points will be awarded to any angler that places in each of the three slam categories. In years past, this has been an almost impossible feat, but now that places are awarded 1st through 5th place, rather than just 1st through 3rd, there is an increased chance that some lucky angler will complete the coveted Slam.

Outdoor News

State of the Causeway Tournament-Saturday, July 31st

Various local conservation organizations and the club are sponsoring the State of the Bay Tournament and Oil Spill Discussion. A captains meeting will be held Thursday July 29th at the Delta Fish House(formerly Oysterellas) from 5:30 pm to 7:30 pm. Speakers will include Dr. George Crozier, Capt. Joey Aburscato, and Ken Rice of the Oiled Wildlife Rehab Center. The tournament will be held on Saturday July 31st from 5 am to 2:30 pm with a weigh-in from 2:30 pm to 3:30 pm at the Delta Fish House. Categories include speckled trout, flounder and blackfish. Tickets are \$10 for adults. Kids 12 and under fish for free. The trout category will have a 14-20 inch slot. 1st and 2nd place finishers will receive cash. There will be band from 4:30 pm to 6:30 pm and a cash bar. The purpose of the tournament is to update local anglers on the state of our waterways, share information, have questions answered and socialize with other anglers. Please consider attending the captains meeting and buying a ticket even if you can't fish the tournament.
