Outdoor News

After a nightmare, Hollywood disaster movie'esque, summer, the gusher has finally been plugged and all Alabama state waters have finally been reopened to catch and keep fishing. It will take years to know the full impact of the Deepwater Horizon spill on the marine ecosystem, but it is nice to have some sense of normalcy finally return. I, for one, was getting pretty sick of looking at boom everywhere.

There is also good news for those of us who occasionally venture into the Gulf. After suffering a chronic case of cranial rectal inversion, the NMFS may actually have a temporary recovery and do something smart for once. The Gulf of Mexico Fishery Management Council has recommended that the 2010 red snapper season be extended since the closures of federal waters due to the oil spill prevented the quota from being filled. The season would be open Fridays through Sundays from October 1st through November 22nd. Although no decision has been made, an official with NMFS has reportedly stated that he did not see any reason why the request would not be granted.
