

Mirabella O'Brien finished 1st Place with a 14.43 pound Blackfish (Tripletail) in the RMYAT (Roy Martin Young Anglers Tournament) held July 12th.

A fair number of ACFA members spent time on the boards of the ADSFR (Alabama Deep Sea Fishing Rodeo) the next weekend. But when the rain and dust finally settled and the cannon sounded, **Andrea Bussie** was the only member remaining on the boards. Andrea finished in 2nd Place in the Non-Motorized Speckled Trout Jackpot with a fine slot speck at 3.44 pounds. That spotted nugget garnered her a fat check, missing out on the \$12K 1st place check by a mere 0.04 pounds! Ohhh, so close!
