President's Message



A short-term dry pattern has developed to begin May, meaning the precipitation for the past couple of weeks has been slightly below average even though the humidity and temperatures are increasing with southerly wind flow. Consequently, the reading at Barry Steam Plant has been "tidal" for the past week or so, and expected to continue like that as long as there is below average rain upstate. While that might bode well for water clarity and higher salinity in the entire bay system, it allows speckled trout to stay farther north to spawn or spread out. Better for the fish maybe than the fishermen...

The day of our May 4th tournament will experience NEAP tides, a real challenge for anglers to find a pattern that produces quality fish. Perhaps our May 2nd meeting speaker, Captain Jay O'Brien, can offer some advice on how to be successful in this situation-Wayne Dean will be there too, speaking on behalf of United Cerebral Palsy, and the outstanding work they do in our community. There will also be UCP representatives on hand like Lockley Shell (their tournament co-founder) present to answer questions about their annual "Hooked Up To Help" tournament that runs simultaneously with the ACFA's. In fact, our ACFA tournament hours are extended an hour, from 1pm to 4pm to match the hours of the UCP tournament. Should be a good time for all Thursday evening and Saturday afternoon! With water temperatures sustained in the middle '70s we can expect many species to be active, especially early and late in the day and around tide changes. Redfish, and especially flounder (which have shown in good numbers so far this year) can be caught even in nearly slack water. So, we hope to see plenty at the weigh-in. John Mareska from Alabama Marine Resources Division will again be at our weigh-in to take clippings of flounder fins for their genetics study on flounder. He will also be at our May 2nd meeting to discuss what they are trying to determine with these samples from all legal flounder, even if they do not place, please bring them to the table to be weighed, measured, and sampled. Pompano is one of our featured species in this month's ACFA tournament, and they have been quite active along the Gulf beaches, even during the previous NEAP tide. Another featured species, white trout have a good reputation for biting during a NEAP tide too. So, these might make good alternates for anglers having problems finding a productive pattern on tournament day in order to "save face".
