President's Message

Hello folks.

Here it is July already. It's HOT of course, and so is the fishing. I have been working with other ACFA board members and friends to find some way for us to hold meetings and tournaments legally and safely. Guidelines laid out by the State Health Department (ADPH) to restrict the spread of the Covid-19 virus, control what we can (or rather cannot) do as a group.



So far, the best option seems to be to try and host the meeting 'virtually' via the internet. **Testing new waters, we intend to try**

that this coming Thursday July 9th at 7pm using the "Zoom meeting" format. This is a powerful online tool which can bring remote people together with an interactive format using their personal computer or even on a cellphone. Not as good as meeting face-to-face, but hopefully the next best thing. Details are included elsewhere in the newsletter, and will be mentioned on the Facebook page, website and our fishing forum...

Following our meeting, we do plan to have our **first tournament of 2020 on July 11th**. Considering we have not been able to have a tournament so far this year, plus the RMYAT will be running concurrently, **ALL TWELVE of the ACFA recognized species will be eligible: speckled trout, redfish, flounder, sheepshead, white trout, groundmullet/whiting, spanish mackerel, blackfish, black drum, croaker, gafftopsail catfish, and pompano. Under the current circumstances, food will NOT be provided!** We must encourage everyone participating in the tournament to weigh their fish and NOT loiter near the tables and board or get in close proximity to the weigh in officials or each other. IF you do remain on the site, PLEASE bring lawn chairs and practice good 'social distancing' with those from other households.

We want everyone to have a good time, but we can't risk anyone getting sick because we did not take proper precautions. To minimalize possible exposure between members and member groups (families) we strongly encourage our members and guests to abide by the prescribed guidelines of social distancing. While at the weigh-in site wear a mask (if possible) especially if you might find yourself standing close or talking to others outside your household group. The weigh-in table will have 'distancing cones and several 5-gallon buckets to help each angler or family group maintain the prescribed social distance (6 feet).

July Tournament Preview

We have a lot of catching up to do with our first tournament coming in JULY! As a result, we are going to open up the tournament this month for **ALL TWELVE ACFA SPECIES**. Bring your legal catches to the weigh-in to score tournament points, win a plaque, and weigh fish for the BFC. Unfortunately, **WE ARE NOT ABLE TO SERVE FOOD** at the tournament.

Tournament details:

- Fish from **5 AM until 3 PM** on **Saturday**, **July 11th**.
- Weigh-in at the American Legion Post 250 on Dauphin Island Parkway from 1-3 PM
- Speckled Trout (slot 15-22"), Redfish (slot 16-26"), Flounder, Sheepshead, White trout, Groundmullet/Whiting, Spanish Mackerel, Blackfish, Black Drum (16-26"), Croaker, Gafftopsail Catfish, and Pompano!
- Points will be assessed for 1st through 5th for each category (Juniors & Adults) and all species in the usual manner.
- Social distancing must be maintained at all times (seriously, we can't risk getting anyone sick!). While at the weigh-in site wear a mask (if possible).
- Final results will be published on the ACFA Facebook page as soon as possible, with point updates to follow.
- ONLY the ACFA Young angler plaques will be printed. Any adults who want a plaque MUST indicate they want a plaque.

For PC, tablets, smartphones using Zoom App:

- 1. On Thursday evening, navigate to Zoom.us/join
- 2. Enter the meeting ID: 996 5094 9054
- 3. You may join using the Zoom App (preferred) or using the browser client (PC only)
- 4. Enter the meeting password if prompted: 868001
- 5. Once you enter the meeting, select Join with Computer Audio or Join with Device Audio to hear the meeting


For call-in on phone (no video):

General tips:


