
March Meeting RECAP - Continued sponsored by:


March Tournament RECAP:

The inaugural ACFA Inshore Championship Series (ICS) tournament was held in conjunction with our regular monthly tournament on March 22nd.


It was a resounding success with 16 entries and 8 fish weighed in. By the rules 1st and 2nd Place receive payout...






