ACFA Rule-Of-100 & Rule-Of-125

This is brand new so pay close attention. Since ACFA is all about fellowship, teaching, and recognition; your leadership has announced the following change in procedure which will be known as the ACFA rule-of-100. In the past ACFA has recognized the 1st place winner of each of our eight Big fish categories by presenting that angler with a plaque at the end of the club year. One plaque per species to the first place winner only.

This year we're instituting the new rule-of-100 whereby as long as the club has 100 or more members we will award second and third place plaques as well in all eight species so that more folks can receive recognition for their catches in our year-long fishing competition. A word of explanation though—although each member can place two fish on the board for each of the eight fish species we will award only one plaque per angler in each of the eight categories. Example: John Doe holds 2nd place in flounder and holds 1st and 3rd in specks. John will receive a second place plaque for flounder and one first place (size) plaque for specks that reads 1st place and 3rd place on the plaque.

And, since our club has enjoyed a banner year and a record membership of 135 your leaders are instituting another beneficial change which we think you'll appreciate. That is the new rule-of-125 which means that as long as ACFA has 125 or more members on the roll we will also award recognition plaques to our anglers who hold all the fourth and fifth place big fish positions. The rule of one plaque per angler (if the angler holds two positions within a species) will extend through these two places also.

So be sure to take another look at our final big fish list for 2004 (see last page) because we'll be passing out up to 32 additional plagues on Thurs, nite and you may now be a recipient of one of these awards.

Spotlight

Although tournament points and positions within the big fish categories are important to our club anglers all year long there is never more significance placed on club standings than now, at the end of our year long competition, when titles, trophies, plaques, and sometimes reputations are on-the-line. Have you ever wondered about how all those competition points and big fish standings are gathered, compiled, and published for you each month? Well, we can assure you that this extremely important function of our club is in exceptionally capable hands thanks to Jennifer Mitternight (wife of Kyle) who has been our statistician since Nov. 2001. This working mother of two has volunteered to keep ACFA on the up-and-up points-wise for the last three years and will once again perform those duties for us in 2005. We don't get to see her at meetings much anymore but she still manages to fish some of our tournaments and she caught the largest speck weighed in on our Challenge in May.

Jennifer is responsible for tallying the points earned on each of our tournaments and updating our tourney standings. Additionally, she keeps the big fish board updated from tournament entries and big fish cards forwarded to her by you the club members. All of these stats. Are compiled and updated on a monthly basis and forwarded to our secretary for publication in the newsletter. And then, at this time of year when both tournament standings and big fish standings are finalized, Jennifer goes through another ACFA formula to ascertain our master angler for the year. Although most of this is on computer memory accuracy is still the key and that's where we depend on the competence of this lady to keep our awards system entirely above board.
