

2. Money owed (10% of gross receipts) from profits realized by individual members at the ACFA Junk Sale or its successors.
 3. Money owed by individual members to cover any guest fees at any ACFA events.
 4. Money owed by members, or others, who pay to sponsor certain ACFA items or events.
(I.E. - Money from Charlie Crawford of Southern-N-Bama to pay for all 8 Big Fish Contest 1st Place Plaques at year's end.)
3. Makes sure all new members have filled out an ACFA membership card — to include an accurate mailing address — before accepting dues payment (in full). Deposits all monies collected to the ACFA account and on a timely basis transmits (to the secretary) all paid members' (both old and new) current addresses to be utilized when compiling the official mailing list. Additionally the Treas. keeps and updates the master ACFA member file noting on each card (usually with the year, I.E. - 2006) when dues are received.

NOTE — REGARDING "NEW" MEMBERS EACH YEAR:
SINCE WE AWARD PRIZES FOR BRINGING NEW MEMBERS INTO THE CLUB IT IS IMPORTANT TO NOTE ON EVERY NEW MEMBER'S CARD WHO "SPONSORED" THEM AND TO BE ABLE TO COMPILE A COMPLETE SPONSOR'S LIST EACH YEAR WITH HOW MANY NEW MEMBERS THEY WERE RESPONSIBLE FOR IN THAT CURRENT YEAR.
