ACFA September "End of Summer" Tournament...

was held on Saturday September 8th during less than typical summer like conditions. A stiff northeast to east wind played havoc with the middle and lower bay, rendering most spots virtually unfishable. Despite the adverse conditions some members persevered and as David Hare put it "face THE BEAST". Still weigh master Pat Hughes managed to catch a very nice speck while throwing a top water bait from the dock at his parents' home on the Sound side of Dauphin Island. Meanwhile at the other end of the bay several boats fishing near the mouth of the Mobile River with live shrimp did well by getting out of the wind and into some fish though they were 'spotty'. In fact "Team LIVE BAIT" swept the white trout category without catching a single keeper speck. And my fishing partner and I, just across the river found some nice specks but not much else (unless you count catfish and ladyfish). Nearby Pat Garmeson landed the top flounder and Mike Foster the first place redfish.

It was not a great day for fishing (or catching) but overall considering the strong winds we did OK.

October 'Causeway Classic' Tournament:

The third Saturday in October is reserved for time honored Southern traditions like (college football and) prime Delta fishing. This year, Saturday **October 20th** is the date of the last ACFA tournament for the 2007 season. And it's your last opportunity to earn tournament points for the year. The top 5 anglers in tournament point totals will earn a trophy or plaque to be given out at the Annual Awards Banquet in December. **Note that a few things are different for this tournament...**

The weigh-in this time around will be held at Scott's Landing just north of the Hwy 90/98 Causeway (aka Battleship Parkway) on the east bank of the Blakely River nearest to Spanish Fort. Just ask anybody where it is...

Secondly, for this tournament the fishing hours run from **6am** to 5 pm, and the weigh-in will be from 3pm till 5 pm (as usual.)
We will have 3 plaques (and points) for 4 species. Those categories are: speckled trout, flounder, redfish (16"- 26" tail-pinched) and sheepshead.
And we will have a special redfish category awarding plaques for any junior angler weighing a legal redfish (slot sized 16"-26"). C'mon kids!!
You can fish anywhere you want to (in Alabama waters), but the rule is you MUST LAUNCH AND RETURN from somewhere on the Causeway.
You don't have to use Scott's ramp. IF you haven't launched there before be aware that parking is limited and we must "park very smart" to maximize the space available. In fact unless you launch from there, it is recommended that you make arrangements to park your rig elsewhere and drive a single vehicle to the weigh-in site to minimize the traffic. And be aware Scott's has only limited drink selection and restroom facilities. Lastly the food at this weigh in will consist of a "Chili Cook-off" featuring teams or individuals who bring a pot (2-3 gallons) of chili to be warmed, judged and consumed. The judging team headed by Randy 'Bigun' Wiscaver will select the three best chili recipes that will receive a plaque at the November meeting. Our president Doug Smith will have more to say on this at the October meeting. We need more teams to cook!!!
