## October 20, 2007: ACFA 'Causeway Classic' Tournament...

was held under ideal early fall like conditions. Clear skies and chilly morning temps of 60 degrees with a light to moderate northerly breeze.

Unfortunately the water temp was still in the mid to upper 70s and the fish had just not quite "turned on" yet. Despite the 'spotty' fishing some fine catches were turned in for weighing, the second heaviest redfish of the year and another speckled trout over 6 pounds! The fishers were spread pretty thin too, fishing in just about every nook and cranny from south of the Causeway north to the islands and everywhere east and west in between.

But once again the Mobile River seemed to take the majority of the big fish catches though some anglers struggled to even get their 'participation point'.

Bill Midgette reported he and his partner Mutt Burke landed several nice specks there and left several even larger ones due to some 'technical difficulties''. Thought there were NO Junior Angler redfish entries it should be noted that Marcus Lanier weighed in an Inshore Slam (speckled trout, redfish and flounder) and placed second in both redfish and flounder. That's NOT an easy feat on any day, much less in a tournament. Congratulations Marcus!

### The Red Cross 'Causeway Classic' Fishing Tournament Is Back!

The American Red Cross Alabama Gulf Coast Chapter Causeway Classic Fishing Tournament begins at daybreak **Saturday November 10, 2007**. Anglers may launch from anywhere along Mobile Bay and adjacent state waters, but must weigh in at 'The Swamp Room' at Felix's Fish Camp on the Causeway from 2-4 p.m. Awards, food, fun and (door) prizes will begin at 4:00 p.m.

Entry fee for adult anglers will be \$25 per angler, and youth anglers (18 and under) \$15 per angler.

Adult Anglers will be competing for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> place in the categories of speckled trout, redfish, and flounder (3 fish creel of each, plus lunker). Junior Anglers will be competing for 1<sup>st</sup> place in speckled trout, redfish, and flounder (3 fish creel of each, plus lunker).

All funds raised from the Red Cross Causeway Classic Fishing Tournament will stay at the local Alabama Gulf Coast Chapter, (Mobile, Baldwin, Clarke, Monroe, and West Escambia Counties,) to help support the programs and services it provides to the community. These programs and services include: Armed Forces Emergency Services, First Aid, CPR, AED Training, Disaster Services during times of any disaster, whether it is a massive hurricane or a single family house fire, and Community Disaster Education.
