Our Last 2004 Tourney: The Causeway Classic

Please note the Oct. tournament date is Sat. Oct. 23rd. Not only is this tourney set for later in the month of Oct. but it's also our last fish fry of this year. That's right—we'll have fried fish with trimmings on the back porch of Liz's Haven, our Classic weigh-in site, directly across from the Battleship on the Mobile Causeway.

The Oct. species will be Speckled Trout, Redfish, White Trout, and Sheepshead. Pat Hughes will run the scales and Charlie Dowdle and crew will be cleaning our catch and "frying 'em up" for all in attendance. Don't miss this one!

Weigh-in will be from 3pm until 5pm and we should have some fried fish by 4. According to ACFA custom <u>all</u> members <u>must</u> launch from and return to a ramp somewhere along the Causeway between the tunnels and Spanish Fort Hill. This is done to assure a level playing field for <u>all</u> our tourney participants. Since Liz has been nice enough to let us use her on-the-water facility we encourage as many of you as possible to launch at her establishment and purchase your fish fry refreshments for the bar inside.
