Our May Tournament--The Speckled Trout Challenge

The following is a reprint of an explanation of the challenge that ACFA has furnished our competition:

Speckled Trout caught (only) on the day of the contest can be entered by members of the competing clubs. Live or artificial bait is allowed but all fish must be caught only by hooks and line (net-caught specs will be dis-allowed). All contestants can launch anywhere in South Alabama and all trout must be caught in Alabama waters to be eligible.

Weigh-in for this tournament will be from 3:30PM til 5PM at the state launching area at Chacaloochee (Chocalatta) Bay approximately mid-way of the Causeway (Hi-way 90 & 98) across upper Mobile Bay/Delta. The weigh-in table will be located at the far western edge of the asphalt, state, parking area (nearest to the service station).

Weighmasters representing both clubs will be present. One digital scale will be utilized and before each fish is weighed the scale must show zero weight. An official weigh-in log will be kept with the following entries noted for each angler weighing in a fish: time, angler's name, weight of angler's fish, and club affiliation. Every angler catching a spec may weigh same and in doing so is certifying that the fish was caught legally by the angler. No check weights will be allowed on the weigh-in scale!

The top 10 specs entered will be awarded placement points from 10 pts. for the largest down to 1 pt. for the 10th largest fish. (Example: 4th largest is worth 7pts. while 8th largest is worth 3 pts.) The available 55 points will be totaled up by club catching those positions and the club winning the challenge will be decided.

On Sat. May 8th we will need as many club fisherpersons fishing for Specs as we as a fishing club can muster! These are a heap of braggin' rights involved in this challenge as well as a traveling trophy (which the losing club must present to the winning club at a future winner's club meeting). Mike Thompson, who's arranging this contest, sure doesn't want to even think

of flaving to do that!

So mark your calendar and fine tune your tackle and fishing rig. Don't let your partner oversleep and we'll see you on the Causeway with your heaviest fish at 3:30-5PM on Sat.

Our award plaques will be presented to every ACFA member who places in any of the top 10 positions. Additionally, one club participation point will be awarded to each member entering a spec and two <u>additional</u> club points will be awarded if your fish is one of the top 10 entered. Need any more info? Get it all the meeting.

And now a word about sportsmanship. There's been a lot said via Internet chatrooms about this challenge and just who are the better fishermen. That's all behind us now and "out-the-door" as we finally get ready to actually fish. Please remember-these folks are fishermen just like us so we've got a lot in common with each other. We don't as yet know them as well as the SWSA folks we've challenged before, but we need to meet them on Sat after-noon and get to know them since, who knows, at some future time we may have to band together to help save our bay or aspects of our sport. So mingle, introduce yourself, and make a new friend or two. We are the "friendly" club--aren't we? Most of these folks could teach each of us a thing or two about eastern shore fishing. And we, in turn, could enlighten them on fishing down the west side of the bay. It's always a pleasure to meet new fishermen and we hope that this is just the beginning of another fishing adventure for each of you. And please-wear your ACFA logo'd caps, tees, fishing shirts, and towels.
