April 2004 Newsletter

The third meeting of the 2004 club year will be on Thursday Apr.. 1st at 7pm at the American Legion Post 88, 2663 Halls Mill Road. Tall stories of your fishing exploits will definitely be accepted on that date and we promise not to cross-examine the fool telling them.

Our main speaker for the evening will be Dr. Bob Shipp, Chairman of the Department of Marine Sciences at the University of South Alabama; Alabama Deep Sea Fishing Rodeo head judge; columnist for a prominent salt-water sporting magazine; and author of "Guide To Fishes Of The Gulf Of Mexico" (probably the most definitive work on gulf fish, their habits, their haunts, and their identification). Dr. Bob will direct his talk to us on the fish stocks in Mobile Bay with (we hope) special emphasis on our Mobile Bay Grand Slam of Speckled Trout, Flounder, and Redfish. Dr. Bob has graciously agreed to bring a limited number of his "Guide To Fishes Of The Gulf" books for sale to those of you who may not have a copy yet. This would be an excellent opportunity to avail yourself of this wonderful identification and informational work.

Our second speaker of Thurs., will be Mr. Allan Stabler of the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary. Allan will briefly update the membership on those safety items which we should have onboard our fishing boats. He will also have a helpful leaflet for each boat owner that should be of great assistance when readying your rig for our voluntary vessel safety check which will be held during our April tournament weigh-in. In addition, Boater's World will have a display (and sale) during our meeting which will consist of new and/or desirable 2004 boating items which should be of interest to all.

April ACFA Tournament

Our April tourney, "breakout", will be held on Sat. April 3rd. We will be fishing for Speckled Trout, Flounder, Sheepshead, and Ground Mullet. 12 awards will be given. Please remember: (1) You can launch and fish anywhere in Southern Alabama, (2) You don't have to fish with an ACFA member and you can fish alone, (3) You can use live or artificial bait (but no nets or dynamite), (4) Slot redfish can be entered for big fish awards on any tourney even when reds are not the designated tournament fish, (5) When fishing with anyone each angler should mark their own fish as only a fish caught by the member entering same can be entered for recognition (The Honor System!) and finally, (6) As long as your fish is a tournament fish and is legal it can be weighed in for a tournament participation point, even though it may not make our ACFA minimum tourney weight for awards consideration.

Weigh-in will be from 3pm to 5pm behind the American Legion Post 250 on D.I.P. (on west side of hiway next to Family Dollar) approx. one block south of Bayley's Restaurant and Greer's Food Tiger. Hot dogs, with all the trimmings, will again be served to all fishermen and their families.

- 1. Sign-in at the door to be eligible for the ACFA grand attendance prize which we award in Dec. This prize already contains more than \$75 worth of items for the winner, with more to be added all year.
- Please wear a name tag---we're trying to get to know you better.
- R(3. Revised 2004 fishing contest rules will again be available at the door. Pick up a sheet if you still haven't done so.
- R 4. Big fish cards are available also.
- R 5. All new members receive a complimentary set of ACFA decals when they join. Did you get yours?
- R 6. At every meeting we are aiming for a 7pm start and we're almost there. Be on time, get a seat, and get ready to enjoy. By the way, so far no meetings have gone past 9pm!

Voluntary Courtesy Boat Inspections

In the interest of boating safety ACFA has again arranged for (voluntary) boat inspections by the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary during our weigh-in hours at the April Tournament (4/3). Allan Stabler will be at the meeting on Thurs, to explain the basic safety points and will have available a safety pamphlet that will inform you which items will be checked on our fishing rig by the auxiliary personnel who will be on site during our tourney weigh-in. Last year over a dozen rigs were offered for inspection and we hope to increase that number in 2004. You don't even have to fish in the tournament—just pull your rig down to the weigh-in site between 3 and 5pm on Sat. Apr. 3rd like several members did last year. This is a non-binding inspection with no

Dw-up nor any penalties. If your rig passes you will receive a safety sticker for display on your boat. The presence of an y-to-date U.S.C.G.A sticker will preclude a whole lot of hassle if you are subsequently checked on the water at a later date. Please try to participate! ACFA encourages safety on the water. And, did you know that with a passing certificate you can purchase any regular safety item at any participating marine store and receive a 10% discount on that purchase?
