Meet the Angler:

Donald Garrettson

Born in Mobile, AL on Sept. 13, 1972, Donald has fished the local waters since his early days in the 70's. His father (Wayne) and uncle (Bruce) would take he and brother (David) to exotic and distant locations such as D'Olive Creek, Bay Minette Creek, and Big Creek Lake. During the summer of 1979 the Tourne' family moved in the house across the street and an addiction for fishing was started. Donald and his best friend Rick learned Mobile Bay fishing with Rick's father (Neal). With access to Rick's grandfather's (Harvey Bryan) aluminum boat "The Boys" fished Dog River and all of its backwaters as often as possible chas-



possible chas- (pic above) Donald holds a full scale 'golden pond punkin'

ing speckled trout, flounder, redfish and bass. In the early 90's the boys built their own wood boat with the help of Ricks father. Gigging flounder and fishing at night for bull reds became a common pastime for the eager young anglers. In 1998 Rick bought his first fiberglass skiff (which Uglystick now owns) and tripletails were the next species added on their list.

In 2000 ACFA club member Budd Barr introduced Donald to the Reggio and Hopedale area of Louisiana fishing for speckled trout and redfish in a new playground. Soon after Donald joined the ACFA and met a plethora of new friends. Past club presidents David Hare, Bruce Howle and Doug Smith to mention a couple, all of whom shared some knowledge (and the occasional "Brogan" joke) with a younger neophyte angler. Since then Donald has served the ACFA as Vice President, Statistician and Logo Items. By 2006 Donald and another club member Erik Nelson were fishing Louisiana and the IFA Redfish Tour. In 2008 (with Erik Nelson on Hiatus) Mark Wright asked Donald to team up with him. By the beginning of 2009 Donald had fished with TV hosts and professional fisherman including Chad Dufrene, Bobby Abruscato, Scott Ritter, Paul Smith, Barnie and Steve White, Charlie Thomason, Blair Wiggins and Greg and Bryan Watts. In 2008 Donald fished an FLW event in New Orleans (Thanks Chad and Barnie) and in 2009 teamed up with Barnie White to win the Gulf Coast Angling Association (now L.A.S.S.) Championship.

Donald has also had several appearances in national and regional publications such as "Great Day Outdoors" (Feb. 2007, Jan. 2010), "Shallow Water Angler" (May 2007), and "Alabama Game and Fish" (June 2009). Donald has 8 local tournament wins, 25 plus top fives and several club tournament wins.

A 1991 graduate of B.C. Rain High School Donald attended the University of Southern Mississippi for one year on a music scholarship before returning to Mobile. There he began working at Barnett Millworks in 1993 and has been employed there ever since, fishing whenever his schedule allows.



The Speckled Trout Challenge...

originated some years ago when Mike Thompson, founder of the then 'upstart' ACFA fishing club challenged the established Saltwater Sportsmen's Association (SSA) to a speckled trout tournament for bragging rights. After six years of friendly competition (and usually ACFA victories) the SSA 'opted out' of the competition in 2004. At that time the newly formed Weeks Bay Fishing Club (WBFC) challenged the ACFA to continue the series. The ACFA prevailed for 7 years in a row and each year the competition lessened. So this year our President has proposed a different kind of challenge hoping to increase the participation and 'fun factor' this tournament once held.

Teams this year are designated as ACFA anglers of 40 years and younger vs ACFA anglers 41 years and older. (it doesn't matter how old ;-)

For the benefit of those members who may not be familiar with this tournament, the format is as follows: <u>Speckled trout ONLY</u>, (plus Jr Speckled <u>Trout</u>). These MUST be caught during the competition hours (**5am to 5 pm Saturday May 5th**) by currently paid members, or qualified family members (spouse or children under age 16). Live and/or artificial baits are allowed, but all specks MUST be caught in a sporting manner on hook and line (NO net caught fish). All contestants must launch and fish in Alabama waters <u>ONLY</u>. Remember, you're on your honor! We are fishing for 'bragging rights' and of course plaques and tournament points (3 points for a Top 10 speck and 1 point for any angler with a 'legal' speck).

The weigh-in will be from 3 pm to 5pm (Sat May 5th) in the parking lot just west of the Public Launch Ramp (known as Chocalotta Bay) on the Highway 90/98 Causeway just west of the I-10 crossover. In addition, again this year the UCP (United Cerebral Palsy) will be having a tournament running concurrently with ours so please remember to "park smart" to allow as many folks as possible access to the launches and tournament weigh-in areas. Park off premises (IF possible) and be sure to secure your equipment from theft. As usual a fish fry will be provided by the ACFA along with cole slaw and cheese grits. You don't want to miss that! Plus it's also a great opportunity to help a worthy cause with UCP (see the flyer on the next page for full details of this concurrent tournament).

Weigh masters representing both tournaments (ACFA and UCP) will be present with separate digital scales to weigh the fish for each tournament. An official ACFA weight log will be kept with notations of the time, angler's name, weight of the fish, Netman, and team affiliation. As soon as the scale officially closes after 5pm, the fish weights will be assessed and points awarded for the top 10 specks. 10 points for 1st place, down to 1 point for 10th place. Example: the 4th heaviest is worth 7 points and the 8th heaviest 3 points, etc. The 55 total available points will be divided up according to the team affiliations of the anglers weighing in those 10 specks. The team with the most total points is declared the winner and will obtain the 'bragging rights' for a full year.

Remember, we are just fishing for ONE big trout. So go get 'em!
