The Mobile River is producing specks for those of you who know this area on pogies. So guys get out and fish the August tournament. There are a few fish still willing to bite if you can stand the heat.

ACFA August Tourney The Mobile Bay Grand Slam

This month's tourney--The Grand Slam- will be held on Sat. Aug. 7th. There are no new or different "boundaries" for this tournament so just get out there and fish. ACFA recognizes the Speckled Trout, the Flounder, and the Redfish as the big three "slam" fish of Mobile Bay and its environs. In addition to these 3 species we will also be targeting the Spanish Mackerel as our fourth species this month. To make it a little easier for an angler to complete an ACFA slam there will be five places (receiving plaques) in each slam-fish category. There will be 3 awards, as usual, for Spanish. That means 18 plaques will be available on this tournament.

To complete the "Slam" and earn 5 additional (bonus) tournament points all you need to do is place first thru fifth in each of the slam-fish categories. (Note-a slam could be completed with three fifth place fish.) Any questions regarding this tourney will be answered at the meeting.

Weigh-in will be from 3pm-5pm, as usual, behind the American Legion Post 250 on D.I.P. about a quarter of a mile south of Bayley's Restaurant. Good Luck to all and see you at the weigh-in!
