He will talk about Speckled Trout in the area and give updates on the latest estimates of population parameters. Marine Resources Division routinely monitors the fishery populations of the area, providing information about the biology, ecology, and health of the fish species.

September Meeting Recap

Please RSVP for the end of the year banquet—a sign-up sheet will be available at the October and November meetings, as well as on ACFA Facebook and the ACFA Forum. The banquet will be at Moe's Original Bar-B-Que downtown.

The two mini-seminars were conducted by Joe Sirmon and Vicki Foster. Joe spoke about networking within the ACFA—there's lots of valuable and helpful information out there—you just have to talk to your fellow anglers! Monthly meetings are a great way to start networking. Vicki Foster spoke about how to be Master Angler. She had a few tips for everyone, including: Fish the tournaments; weigh something in because you never know what will win—all 1st place fish are worth 5 points, no matter what category; weigh-in fish to put on the Big Fish Board and send in your card(s); and you need good bait and some good game plans for tournament day!

Joey Gates discussed fall/winter fishing in the delta and shared quite a few tips for running the tricky areas and rigging up your gear. He stressed careful navigation and suggests following someone for the first couple of times until you are comfortable running it on your own—there are really shallow areas that sneak up on you! The delta is usually packed with boats, so have patience and ease through when you're unsure. The fall—winter season brings good Speckled Trout fishing the entire time (even top water), as well as bass fishing up the Tensaw river. Look for birds in the fall. With little to no rain, specks can be found all the way up to Gravine Island. Lastly, don't be afraid to stop and watch the bottom machine for deeper water!

END OF SUMMER TOURNAMENT RECAP

The weigh-in was a bit interesting this time around. Normally speckled trout are the most commonly weighed in species and Spanish Mackerel one the least weighed species. Not this year! Spanish Mackerel were high on numerous anglers' hit list and some really nice fish came in early and often. The trio of Mark McPherson, Brad McDonald and Norman Lewellen sat in the top three spots for the highly targeted Spanish Mackerel until John Howard and partner David Hare arrived. John swiped the top spot with a very respectable 4.5# mackerel and partner David slid in the 5th spot with a solid 3# Spanish. John didn't stop with the Mackerel; he also placed in speckled trout and white trout.

The fried fish provided by food advisors Tom Brooks and Kyle Eckhoff was well received by all tournament participants. Without these guys we would go hungry. A big thanks to everyone who helped out with the Fish Fry! Sorry but last names got lost in the shuffle, so per Kyle Eckhoff's memory....Johnny with the broken thumb, John the taste tester, and Kyle from Fairhope, Tom Brooks, and Gary Tingle were all instrumental in the efforts. They were great! Also, about 20 people helped break things down and it was a great team effort. Thanks to everyone.


