May Tournament--The Speckled Trout Challenge

Background: As the "new kid on the block" ACFA challenged the older club in town (The Saltwater

Sportsman's Ass'n) to a speckled trout tournament to be held in May of each club year. After six successful years, during which ACFA prevailed most of the time, the Saltwater Sportsmen acknowledged ACFA as the winner of the challenge trophy and opted out of the friendly competition in 2004. At that time another, newer fishing club from Baldwin County asked if they could compete against ACFA and continue the contest. ACFA agreed and that new club known as the Weeks Bay Fishing Club began our series of the Challenge last year (2004). ACFA won last year's initial tourney and presently has possession of the new rotating trophy.

Scoring: The top 10 specks entered by either club are awarded placement points from 10 points for the largest down to 1 point for the 10th largest fish. (IE-4th largest speck is worth 7 points while the 8th largest is worth 3 points.) The available 55 points will then be totaled up by club catching these positions and the 2005 champ will

be decided, and the trophy will reside with that club for a year.

Weigh-in: Weigh-in for the challenge, <u>complete with fried fish</u>, will be held on the back porch of Liz's Haven (across from the Battleship) on the Causeway from 3 to 5pm on Sat. May 7th. Only one speck per club member is allowed to be weighed in and no check weights are allowed on the weigh master's scale. <u>All</u> "challenge" fish will be weighed on the same, single scale! Note: ACFA Big Fish Contest fish such as Reds, Flounders, White Trout, etc. can also be weighed for your Big Fish cards.

ACFA participation points will be awarded to all our members who weigh a speck or a red. Additionally 2 tournament points will be awarded to all ACFA members who make the top ten specks entered!

Other: Volunteers are needed on Sat. for the cooking crew and for fish cleaning on Liz's back pier. <u>Please</u> help our club and let the president know you will assist! Also--if you have any amount of frozen fish fillets please bring those to the meeting Thurs. the president will have an ice chest available for them since we need some to get started with on Sat.

WBFC is composed of a great group of guys who are very good speckled trout fishermen. ACFA will need a good turnout of our fisherpersons to have a chance of winning this challenge. This event will go on rain or shine so please support your club and fish! Also, at the weigh-in, get to know as many of the challengers as you can. It will be to your benefit since we all have a great sport in common. More at the meeting!
