July Tournament Recap:

Some great early summer weather graced the ACFA July Tournament held on July 5th. Despite the holiday weekend crowds good numbers of really fine fish were caught, especially at the lower end of the bay around the gas rigs and the 'Shoals'. Just 15 minutes after the scales opened Bruce Howle, Sr and his daughter Brittney Howle weighed a 5 speckled trout creel of 18.45# tying the 2006 record set by Todd Golomb and Hal Scheurich. And only a few minutes after that Tommy Pond and Billy Hurd entered an incredible 20.55# creel that smashed the former record by over 2 pounds. Well done!! Wish we had a picture... A total of 43 anglers entered speckled trout in the tournament, our best showing by far for this year. Other fish weren't slacking either, as (even though they weren't a category this month) some really nice ground mullet (Southern Kingfish) were entered in the Big Fish Contest by **Shane Ford** and his son **Daniel Ford**. But those were eclipsed by **Bill Perry**'s 2.45# record catch (below). And the fun didn't end with the fishing either. The 'hotdogs' that Brenda and Steve Wilson cooked (with helper Marc Kruse) were some of the extraordinary sausages we got to sample outside at the July meeting. ACFA August 'Mobile Bay Grand Slam' Tournament and Membership Shrimp Boil...

will be held on Saturday August 9 with the weigh-in from 3-5pm at the usual place, behind the American Legion Post 250 on Dauphin Island Parkway (Hwy 193) just south of the Greer's Foodstore.

The ACFA recognizes **speckled trout, redfish, and flounder** as the three species comprising a Grand Slam for Mobile Bay and its connecting waterways. Catching fish of all three species in a single day is considered a fine accomplishment among inshore fishers and to do it during a tournament is even more outstanding and deserves of special recognition. So to 'sweeten the pot' as it were the ACFA is awarding plaques and points for 5 places (1st through 5th) for these three species. In addition any angler who completes the Grand Slam **and places in each** of these three categories (1st -5th) will be awarded 5 additional (bonus) tournament points! To the best our knowledge this has only been accomplished three times since 1997, the last time was in 2004 by Bill Midgette. To clarify, an angler can do this with even 3 fifth place fish!

And again this year, the ACFA will give a plaque of recognition (with no additional points) to the angler who catches the heaviest combined weight of the three 'Grand Slam' species (even if none of them place in their respective categories).

White trout and blackfish will the other two species eligible for plaques and points and (again) the Junior anglers will compete for plaques in all five species. So good luck to you all, fish hard and get your share of the action.

In appreciation of ALL our members, the ACFA is planning a Shrimp Boil 'feed down' at the weigh-in site. All paid members, their spouses and children are invited to attend and partake in the boiled shrimp, potatoes, corn and sausage that our fine cooking crew (headed by **Randy Wiscaver** 'Bigun') has assembled. So when you bring your fish to weigh in, bring your 'feed bag' (appetite) and the family for an afternoon of good eats and good company compliments of YOUR fishing club, the ACFA.

NOTE: as always guests are welcome. But PLEASE if you bring someone not eligible for ACFA benefits (anyone other than a spouse and/or child dependant), make a \$5 per person donation to help the club cover the cost. Thank you for your cooperation.
