The reports from the Causeway and Delta anglers were pretty spotty with many folks catching only a handful of fish all morning long though Les Smith, Donnie Fassbender and Billy Hurd managed to 'solve the riddle' well enough to place in two categories each.

Six club members fished the Dauphin Island Pier and five caught spanish mackerel while the intrepid duo of Jim Foster and Patric Garmeson "took a few over the bow" dodging thundershowers just offshore of the island hunting for that illusive big mackerel. At least they caught a lot of fish!

### **October 'Causeway Classic' Tournament:**

The third Saturday in October is reserved for time honored Southern traditions like prime Delta fishing.

So this year, Saturday **October 21st** is the date of the last tournament of the year for the 2006 season.

So this is your last opportunity to earn tournament points for the year. The top 5 anglers in tournament point totals will earn a trophy or plaque to be given out at the Annual Awards Banquet in December.

There are several things different in the format of this tournament: one is the weigh-in will be held at Scott's Landing just north of the Hwy 90/98 Causeway (aka Battleship Parkway) on the east bank of the Blakely River. Just ask anybody...

Second, for this tournament the hours run from **6am** to 5 pm and the weigh-in will be from 3pm till 5 pm as usual.

We will have 3 plaques (and points) for 4 species. Those categories are: speckled trout, flounder, redfish (16"- 26") and sheepshead.

You can fish where you want to, but the rule is you **MUST LAUNCH AND RETURN** from somewhere on the Causeway.

You don't have to use Scott's ramp. IF you haven't launched there before be aware that parking is limited and we must "park very smart" to maximize the space available. In fact unless you launch from there, it is recommended that you make arrangements to park your rig elsewhere and drive a single vehicle to the weigh-in site to minimize the traffic.

Our president Doug Smith will have more to say on this at the meeting and will likely announce what culinary "surprise" Randy 'Bigun' Wiscaver and his cooking committee have in store for us.

### **The Mini-Seminars Continue:**

IF you are not familiar with fishing the Mobile River Delta or haven't heard Mutt Burke's outstanding presentation about it, then this is your big chance. At 6 pm, prior to the meeting Thursday October 5th in the meeting hall, Mutt will let loose of some of those tips and tactics that he has acquired from his many years of fishing in the Delta. And with any luck he'll have some of those nifty maps he has drawn up as handouts.
