#### Roads To Reefs Now Complete

Marine Resources has now established the final three artificial reefs that were planned for this program. The Brookley Hole Reef is in place in deep water in front of the Brookley Golf Course. Two poles with 2 signs each indicate the location. The actual reef material is located approximately 35'-40' west of (behind) the two posts. The Upper Bay Barge reef is also in place and well marked. This reef is approximately a mile off the Eastern Shore and west of the Red Bluff in the Montrose area. Several poles with signs indicate the spot. And finally, the sunken boat which is southwest of the south tip of Coffee Island in Mississippi Sound has been enhanced with reef material. This wreck was originally marked with a single post and sign with "WR" on it. That post has been joined by several additional posts with signs for easy location and identification. This reef is about 1 1/4 miles off Coffee on the way out to the Blue Rig. Come next year, all of these should produce for local fishermen.

#### Nominations For 2004 Club Year

The ACFA nominating committee is working to solidify our leadership team for next year. We hope that if you are (or have been) contacted you will seriously consider volunteering to serve your club. We are blessed with many great members, but far too few understand that every once in awhile each of us needs to try to repay ACFA for the many benefits we have gained from our affiliation with this club. Remember----without a leadership team in 2004 there will be no ACFA in 2004! Please step forward in Nov. to assure an ACFA in the future. If not now--when? If not you--who?

Following is a list of ACFA positions/tasks with an overview of each.

<u>President</u>--Chairs executive committee meetings as needed. Represents ACFA at functions as required. Has final word on all club business/ decisions. Focuses on the overall club direction. Makes the agenda for each meeting and runs the meeting. Helps line up monthly speakers.

<u>Vice President</u>—Fills in/presides for president as required. Assists president with such tasks as required. Selects, confirms, and coordinates monthly weigh-in sites. Acts as tourney weighmaster or appoints someone on a tourney by tourney basis. Lines up

speakers/displays for monthly meetings.

<u>Treasurer</u>—Is <u>unscrupulously honest!</u> Handles sign-up of new or repeat members and receives dues, any funds raised, or monetary donations. Keeps the membership card file. Forwards member's names and addresses to secretary. Deposits all club monies into ACFA bank account. Dispenses club obligations, writing checks on club bank account as required. Keeps track and reports, as required, on club bank balances.

<u>Secretary</u>--Gathers all club information from various members on a timely basis in order to assemble same. Notifies Mobile Press (via Fax) of club meetings for publication. Assembles monthly newsletter, types and copies for the mailing, places in envelopes, stamps and mails same. Types donation request letters (using ACFA letterhead) and other

correspondence/paperwork as required.

<u>Statistician</u>--Gathers information from ACFA tourneys and big fish cards, assigns points per ACFA rules, and produces the tourney standings & big fish standings thru-out the club year. Sends this info to sec'y monthly.

Membership--Works (at the discretion of the Pres.) on activities related to membership such as greeting arrivals at meetings, greeting speakers, general information regarding club membership, running the meeting sign-in, and giving out name tags. Weighmaster--Keeps the ACFA digital scale, tournament log book, and runs the tourney weigh-in 7 times a year (for 2 hours each: 3pm-5pm), at predetermined club weigh-in sites on designated Saturdays. Assembles info from weigh-in and provides same for ordering trophies for next meeting.

<u>Donations</u>—Utilizing ACFA form letter on letterhead paper (typed and copied by the secretary) delivers these letters to businesses and restaurants to obtain "give-a-way" items for club meetings. Follows up delivery to pick-up items or to further

explain request.

<u>Caps and tee-shirts</u>--Obtains basic caps as required and takes prepaid requests for 2 types of logos on same at meetings. Forwards cap orders and money to monogram shop and picks up completed caps before next meeting for delivery to members. Takes prepaid orders for club tees at meetings. Forwards orders and money to screening source and picks up completed tees, pays bill, and delivers tees at next meeting. (1 or 2 times per club year).

<u>Awards</u>--Obtains from weighmaster or statistician winners names, fish species, and fish weights and delivers to trophy source.

Awards—Obtains from weighmaster or statistician winners names, fish species, and fish weights and delivers to trophy source. For club tourneys—picks up completed plaques, pays source, and delivers plaques to monthly meeting. For end of year awards receives info from "stats" and delivers to trophy source. For. Dec. meeting picks up completed awards, pays source, and

delivers final awards to meeting.
