President's Message:

But speckled trout and redfish still remain in decent numbers in the tidal rivers along the bay such as Dog, Fowl, Fish, and Magnolia rivers. If you want to chase something without spots then head toward the lower end of the bay and fish the rigs, bridges, and jetties for sheepshead. These will not typically be the big giant spring time sheepshead but you could fill the boat with scrappy 2 lbs-5 lbs fish.

ACFA 2011 Awards Banquet Recap

Over 135 members and guests attended the 15th Annual ACFA Awards Banquet held Friday evening December 2, 2011. Over 75 awards and trophies were given out and mass quantities of HOT seafood and side dishes from **Fishhead's Catering** were consumed along with numerous "scrumptious" desserts and hors d'oeuvres contributed by the attending members. It was another great ACFA party, featuring the band "Mystifiers". So if you missed it, then you REALLY missed it! Of course the focus of the evening was the award presentations.

Our 2011 Big Fish Champions were:

Harrison, 3rd Chris Conken, & 5th place Jerry Markow Redfish: 1st place Jarred Kelly 7.30#, 2nd place Erik Nelson, 3rd Trevor Harrison, 4th Rob Howell, & 5th place Theo Koulianos White Trout: 1st and 5th place O.P. Harrison (3.06#), 2nd place Marty Garmeson, 3rd Trevor Wood, & 4th place Vicki Foster All the overall winners in the yearlong Big Fish Contest are assigned points based on the number and place of fish they had in the final 2011 Big Fish Contest results. We refer to this as the Big Fish Championship. Based on these point totals 5th place went to Phillip Guy, 4th place was a tie between Vicki Foster and Jerry Markow, 3rd place was Kyle Mitternight, 2nd place went to O.P. Harrison and the 2011 Big Fish Champion was (again) David Thornton. Not a bad run for a guy who fishes from a pier most of the time. But that is proof that just about anyone in the club is capable of putting together an award winning season (or two;-) So get after them!

In addition we recognized the accomplishments of club members who consistently placed in our (8) monthly tournaments by their standings in accumulated point totals at the end of the competition season. Michael Nicholas and Doug Tierce tied for 5th place, O.P. Harrison 4th place, Mike Foster 3rd place, Trenny Woodham was 2nd place and our **2011 Tournament Champion was Vicki Foster**. Also we mathematically compare each individual's rank in the Big Fish Contest and Tournament point totals to determine an overall champion. By virtue of a half point difference, our coveted **2011 Master Angler was Vicki Foster**. She was also the **Lady Angler of the Year**. We use the same formula (lending equal weight to both contests) to select the overall junior angler and new angler for each year too.

Thus the 2011 ACFA New Angler Trophy went to Michael Nicholas and the 2011 Junior Angler Trophy was awarded to Trevor Harrison.

The "Founder's Award" is another coveted trophy. Each year it is presented to the individual in the ACFA who is considered to have advanced the club by giving time and effort beyond expectations or job description. For his tireless work in 2011 the Founder's Award went to Vince Hawkins.

A very important part of the success of the ACFA is the support of the club by individuals, businesses and organizations who help us out. At the end of each year the club tries to recognize (albeit in a small way) the most deserving of them for their contributions with a plaque of recognition. In 2011, the ACFA recognized **Post 250**, **The American Legion** (tournament weigh in site), **Scott's Landing** (for contributions and use of weigh in site), **Middle Bay Marine** (financial support throughout the year), **Southern Bama Bait & Tackle** (Big Fish Contest plaques and monthly door prizes, **Deer River Bait & Tackle** (for support and contributions), and especially to Angel and Steve of **ABC Trophy Center** (for their continued support and patience and doing such a wonderful job with our plaques and trophies!).

The last award given during the evening was the **Grand Attendance Prize** drawing (an ice chest filled with lures and other 'goodies' **worth in excess of \$750**). About 30 members qualified for the drawing (by attending at least 8 of the 10 regular monthly club meetings). The 'lucky' member for 2011 was **Jay O'Brien**. Congratulations to all our 2011 award winners and THANKS to all who made it possible!

The Mini-Seminars will return...

The huge popularity and success of the Mini-Seminar Series is due in large part to the efforts of member Joe Sirmon who spearheaded the idea years ago. Meet the Angler

Born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania on August 7th 1980. Patric moved with his family to Spanish Fort, Alabama in 1985. He was taught the art of fishing at the early age of 2 by his mom and dad. And his first memorable accomplishment as a fisherman was at the young age of 9, when he landed a 9.5 lbs bass on a private lake in Brewton, Alabama. Patric was immediately touched with a sense of stewardship after his remarkable catch, and he turned from a child to a conservationist. Since that day he has always made it a point to strive to return breeder size fish back to the water whenever possible.

In 1998 he graduated from Daphne High School and later attended Faulkner State Community College. In 2001 he completed college with a golf course management degree. In 2006 he was encouraged by Leslie and Doug Smith to join the ACFA. This was a decision he made not knowing what to expect from the club. His first season was highlighted by fishing an extremely rough day in the gulf in a small boat while in pursuit of spanish mackerel. And he placed in his first ACFA tournament that day!

In 2007 he managed to place in enough tournaments to finish the year tied for 1st in points with his step father Mike Foster and longtime member Bill Midgette. In 2008 he and his partners (Jim Foster and Adam Barker) made a run once again with Jim Foster running away with the point championship. Then in 2009 Adam Barker would not be left out in the cold. With Patric at the helm most of the time, Adam made a strong end of the season push and took home the club points championship that year.

From 2008-2009 Patric helped the club out by setting up the mini seminars for the meetings. In 2010-2011 he served as ACFA vice president and obtained his United States Coast Guard Captain license. During this time he started his fishing charter business "Ugly Fishing" www.uglyfishing.com and was working with fellow club member Doug Tierce doing home remodeling. Patric was featured in a Mobile Register Outdoors article "Spoon Fed Specks" in 2010. During January 2011 Patric and fishing partner Adam Barker broke their Battle of the Grubs (BOG) curse and landed a 3rd place speckled trout creel and 1st place redfish calcutta (this personal victory came at the cost of a blown outboard and had to be towed in by fellow anglers Bruce Howle and Jimmy Quint). Also in 2011 Patric made a career change to the lawn and landscape industry with Sexton Lawn and Landscape of Daphne. This career has allowed him time to fish most every weekend and to run charters when his schedule will allow.

Patric's biggest news of 2011 came on the date of 11-11-11 when he exchanged vows with his new bride Autumn Lundy. And just recently the newlyweds have announced they will be expecting a child in September! Autumn has been an active club member for 2010 and 2011 seasons along with her now 10 year old daughter, Chloe. They both have enjoyed fishing with Patric for fun and during tournaments and look forward to their growing family. Now in 2012 Patric resides over the ACFA as club president and is very motivated to draw new members as well as provide a better experience to those who have already been club members.

Jump Start for Spring

The thing I'd like to start with is checking out my trailer. First I need to check all lights and connections.

Then I need to check hubs and axles, and then check tires for wear.

I'd like to start off with a good coat of wax inside and out. Clean all connections on batteries for the motor and trolling motor. I go through all of my pumps and switches on console to make sure it's all working properly.

I also like to check all flares and fire extinguisher to make sure they're up to date.

Just a few items to start working on before Spring arrives.




