If you go fishing and catch a quality fish, be sure to get an official weight on a certified scale (which can be found at almost any bait shop). Also, our tournaments are once per month and are all capped off by some fine eats at the weigh-in. The ACFA August tournament is a huge challenge to beat both the heat and your competition. Good luck to all and don't forget to purchase Conde Cavaliers Rodeo tickets so you can weigh in your fish at the ACFA weigh-in and then the Conde's weigh-in.


Conde Cavaliers member, Eddie Naron, will also be available to speak about the upcoming tournament and answer any questions you may have.




