### ACFA December Awards Banquet Preview

It's still not too late to schedule your appointment for a test ride in a Skeeter boat to qualify you for the free \$1800 power pole drawing to be held at the Awards Banquet on Friday December 7th. The food at the banquet will be catered bar-b-q chicken, pulled pork and ribs from Sonny's Bar-B-Que. Sorry, no shrimp this year ;-). Be sure to let Patric know you are coming (and how many others). Sponsors, members and their immediate family eat free, but we ask \$15 per guest to cover the cost. There will be a DJ on hand to play music after the award ceremony is complete.

As always you are requested to bring a dessert or hors-de-vors (be sure to have a serving spoon with your name on it).

Tea and lemonade will be provided, but if you want anything else to drink (besides water) it's BYOB.

There will be a live auction for Bill Midgette's tackle box loaded with his customized lures. Also, club member Steve O'Dell has donated a stained glass redbfish that will look great hanging on anyone's wall or 'mancave'. So bring yer checkbook made out to ACFA! The Tournament Attendance Drawing (a custom built rod by ACFA member Tom Wicker) will be held for everyone who weighed in at least one fish in a tournament. They also have one additional chance to win for each tournament you weighed a fish (up to 8 chances). The Grand Prize Drawing will be held at the conclusion of the awards and this year is a blue 40 quart Icy-Tek cooler (donated by **Bill Chapman of Coastal Angler Magazine**) and it will be loaded with tackle and various other sponsor and member donated items.

### How the Master Angler is determined—Doing the Math...

When the concept came up to determine a club Master Angler for each year by evenly comparing our two vastly different contests it was determined that a 'head to head' comparison based on placement in each contest was the best way. How an angler places in the Final Tournament standings is placed beside an equal number of Big Fish Contest anglers (in this case 28) and each angler is assigned a point value based on their ranking. Ties share the average points for those places (an even number of ties results in .5 pts). Then the points for each angler are combined and ranked to determine the overall Master Angler rankings (below right).

For example: this year Trenny Woodham was 1st place in Tournament points (28.0) + 3rd place in Big Fish Contest (26.0) = 54.0 pts

O.P. Harrison was 3rd in Tournament points (26.0) + 2nd in Big Fish points (27.0) = 53.0 points

Jay O'Brien was tied for 4th in Tournament points (24.5) + 6th in Big Fish points (23.0) = 47.5 points etc. etc...

The top ranked Lady Angler (L), New Angler (N), and Junior Angler (J) are likewise determined by their point combinations.

The size of the speckled trout entered in the ACFA Big Fish Contest this year has easily eclipsed past performances, and has set a new bar to which the club will likely compare for years to come. Congratulations to all who caught these tremendous speckled trout! It is a fine accomplishment for any angler in the club to catch such a magnificent sized trout and the fact that all of our Top 10 Speckled Trout (plus some of the CPR trout) were 7 pounds or better says a lot about the level of fishing prowess in the club, and one we can all share in. All four of the 8 pound specks caught his year are now in the record Top 10 overall. (see table below)
