Mobile's Unparalled Trout Tactician and Causeway/Delta Aficionado

ACFA charter member "Mutt" Burke has graciously agreed once again to share some of his 35+ years of causeway and lower delta fishing expertise with our club. When the fish are found, most of us can usually come up with a method to catch them; But where to locate them in the fall in the many bays, creeks, and rivers of the lower Delta presents somewhat of a problem to even the seasoned coastal fisherman. Pair this with the added task of safely navigating the "skinny-water" delta areas such as south-of-the-bayway, Spanish River to Mobile River cut-through, or the East-West channel through Chocolatta Bay, and many anglers feel a bit overwhelmed when confronted with a causeway trip.

Not to worry--with Mutt's maps and fishing tips you'll be able to knowledgeably talk about the "bubble-ups", Brookley channel, Spookville, the several channels of Devil's cut, and Turtle Ditch. Bring your causeway questions. Mutt will answer them and we'd bet that you'll catch more fall fish too!

Our "Causeway Classic" is more than 2 weeks <u>after</u> this meeting so you'll have plenty of time to concentrate on the Delta, find your way around, and catch some fish beforehand. Don't miss this presentation!

Please give Jimmy a helping hand if called upon. And remember, if you need a beverage to go along with that fish, Liz has whatever you may require just steps away from the launch ramp.
