Red Cross Causeway Classic-October 10th

The American Red Cross Alabama Gulf Coast Chapter and Verizon Wireless will host the “Red Cross Causeway Classic Trout, Redfish & Flounder Tournament” on October 10, 2009 at The Swamp Room at Felix’s Fish Camp. This year’s tournament is sponsored by Pilot Catastrophe Services, Verizon Wireless, and The SSI Group, Inc. All anglers, young and the young at heart, are encouraged to participate in the Red Cross Causeway Classic. Entry fee for adult anglers will be \$25 each, and youth anglers (18 and under) \$15 each. The Red Cross Causeway Classic will begin at daybreak, anglers may launch from anywhere along Mobile Bay and adjacent waters, and must weigh-in at Felix’s Fish Camp from 2:00-4:00 p.m. Awards, food, fun and prizes will begin at 4:15 p.m. for anglers, families and friends. Adult and Youth Anglers will be competing in the categories of 3 fish creel on speckled trout, largest speckled trout, 2 fish creel on flounder, largest flounder, largest redfish and master angler. All funds raised from the Red Cross Causeway Classic Trout, Redfish & Flounder Tournament will stay at the local Alabama Gulf Coast Chapter.
