Catch, Photo and Release (CPR) Speckled Trout Contest Standing as of August 24, 2012

At least the top 5 place CPR Speckled Trout will receive plaques at the end of the year.

Keep in mind that EVERY participation point you earn in each of our 8 club tournaments gives you another chance in our 'PP Drawing' at the end of the year Awards Banquet (held in December).

ACFA is a local inshore saltwater fishing club. Meetings are held the first Thursday of each month to promote friendship, sportsmanship, and **conservation** along coastal Alabama.

New: NETMAN (or WOMAN) of the Year Category!

19. Any ACFA angler at the time of their weighing in a tournament fish who declares the eligible member or dependant who actually netted that fish for them (including themselves) will be awarded the same number of points in a separate category called "Netman of the Year". These points will be tallied and kept for the duration of the tournament season and the angler with the most accumulated "net" points will receive this award during the December Banquet.

NOTE: these point totals are entirely separate from the traditional Tournament Point Standings and have no bearing on the Tournament Points or Master Angler

A Storm Statement:

was added to the ACFA by-laws after 2005's busy hurricane season interrupted our tournament and meeting schedule.
Let's hope bringing this up doesn't 'hex' us, but it seemed timely to republish it with the heart of the season upcoming.
"If a named tropical storm or hurricane is predicted to strike the Gulf Coast within approximately 140 miles east or west of Mobile (including the area between New Orleans, LA and Panama City, FL) on or close to a scheduled ACFA Saturday tournament, that tourney will automatically be postponed until the following Saturday (unless that Saturday falls on the weekend of the Alabama Deep Sea Fishing Rodeo in which case it will be postponed 2 weeks later)."
Additional note: IF a hurricane is immediately threatening our area or a curfew is in effect in the City of Mobile (following a hurricane landfall) at the time of our scheduled monthly meeting, that meeting will be cancelled (and not rescheduled).
All business pertinent to that meeting (plaque presentations, etc.) will be done at the next scheduled meeting the following month.
Hopefully, we won't have to implement this but we wanted everyone to be aware of our procedures in the event of a hurricane.
You can rest assured there will be a discussion about it on our website IF conditions warrant or you can contact one of our club chairpersons listed in the masthead at the top of this newsletter.

Alabama Fishing License Renewal:

By the time you read this your 2012 fishing licenses will be expired! All Alabama licenses for anglers age 16 to 65 expire every year on August 31st. Licenses are available in many stores, by phone @ 1-888-848-6887 or on the internet @ <http://www.outdooralabama.com/fishing/saltwater/license/>

In addition, as of June 2011 FREE Saltwater Angler Registration is required annually for all residents who take, catch, kill, posses fish or attempt to catch, kill or posses fish in the saltwater jurisdiction of Alabama. **This includes residents who are not required to purchase an annual saltwater license** such as those over the age of 64, have a lifetime saltwater license or fish exclusively on a pier that has purchased a pier fishing license (Cedar Point Pier is the only pier in Alabama). You can register by using the website posted above. The Saltwater Registration uses the license purchase web site but you will not be charged for a Saltwater Registration.
