Outdoor News

The Stormin Norman Inshore Challenge

The fourth annual Stormin Norman Inshore Challenge will be held Saturday, June 20, 2009 at the Fairhope Yacht Club located at 101 Volanta Ave. in Fairhope. Tickets are \$20 per angler, up to 4 anglers per boat. (This is a boat team tournament). There is also an optional \$10 lunker fee for each species, as well as a junior category for the heaviest fish in each species category. Categories include: speckled trout (5 fish creel); redfish (3 slot fish creel); flounder (3 fish creel) and tripletail (heaviest single fish). A mandatory captains meeting will be held Thursday, June 18 at 6PM at Fly Creek Cafe located at 831 N Section St. in Fairhope. The calcutta meeting will follow. Fishing hours are from safe light until 3 p.m. All anglers must check in with the weighmaster by 3PM. For full rules and regulations go to: http://www.storminnorman.org/rules-a-registration.html. Like every year, proceeds from the Stormin Norman tournament go to support a local young family that has lost a spouse and parent. This is a great tournament that is whole lot of fun and for a great cause. ACFA members have shown strong support in past years, and we hope that will continue this year.

Mobile County Wildlife and Conservation Association tournament

The Mobile County Wildlife and Conservation Association will have its 20th Annual Speckled Trout Tournament on June 20th. There are three divisions available. The Lunker Division tickets are \$50, and the category pays \$300 cash for the heaviest speck weighed in during the tournament. The "Lucky Division" tickets are \$25, and includes three categories: speckled trout, flounder, and sheephead. An angler need only weigh in a fish from any, or all three of the categories and be eligible for prize drawings. The prize in each category for the first drawing is \$150; the prize for the second drawing in each category is an inshore rod and reel combo, and the prize for the third drawing in each category is a mystery prize. The third category is the Youth Division. Children under 12 fish free and are eligible for recognition for three categories: speckled trout, flounder, and sheephead. Anglers may weigh in at either the Grand Hotel in Pt. Clear, or Dauphin Island Marina. The weigh in is from 2-5 p.m. at both locations. Tickets are available at McCoys, SouthernBama, Quints, Fisherman's Discount, Battles Wharf Mini Mart or by calling 251-234-8156. Proceeds go to fund MCWCA's long term project of planting native aquatic vegetation in the Delta.

Jemison's will be around until at least 2013

The Mobile County Commission has reached an agreement with Jemison's Bait Shop which will allow it to remain in operation at its current location through the entirety of its current lease through the the year 2013. The strong support of recreational anglers helped convince local officials the property's best use was its current use. The launch at Jemison's will now reportedly be free of charge to all anglers.

Redfish Club Challenge

The 3rd unofficial Redfish Club challenge was held between the Down Da Bayou Redfish Club of Louisiana and ACFA anglers in Hopedale, LA on May 16th. ACFA anglers pulled off the upset the first year on the home team's turf, and lost by a mere 7 points last year even though outnumbered 24 boats to 9. Unfortunately, this year the DRBC showed no mercy and hammered the away team by taking the first 9 of the 10 scoring spots. Capt. Scott Ritter, and his brother John Ritter managed to take 10th place while fishing for Team Alabama to barely prevent the sweep. In total, ACFA anglers in 7 boats competed against 23 DRBC teams. Nearly ideal conditions resulted in 7 of the top 10 teams bringing in 2 fish stringers over 15 lbs, with the top 19 teams all cracking 14 lbs. In redfish tourney terms, that's a lot of beef. In spite of the outcome, everybody had a great time and look forward to taking another crack at'em next year.
