## ACFA Rule-Of-100 And Rule-Of-125

By way of explanation--when our club was growing and we had less than 100 members we awarded plaques to only the eight people who had the first place big fish. When we went over the 100 membership mark we awarded plaques to 1<sup>st</sup> thru 3<sup>rd</sup> big fish winners. And when we topped 125 members we started giving plaques to all on the big fish board--a practice that continues this year.

A word of further explanation--although each member can place two fish on the big fish board for each of eight fish species we will award only one plaques per angler in each species category. Example: John Doe holds 2<sup>nd</sup> place in redfish and holds 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in specks. John will receive a second place plaque for redfish and one first place (size) plaque for specks that reads 1<sup>st</sup> place and 3<sup>rd</sup> place on the plaque.

So be sure to take a good look at our final big fish standings for 2005 because we'll be awarding up to 40 plaques at our Dec. function and you may be a recipient. Congratulations to all of our finalists, and a big "thank you" to member Charlie Crawford, owner of Souther-N-Bama, for once again sponsoring our 8 first place big fish awards.
