Redfish will be commonly found near grass flats and structure in all these areas. Flounder made a pretty good run in Dog River a few weeks ago and are showing their faces in many of the same areas as the speckled trout and redfish.

June's meeting will feature a guest speaker who understands the "who, what, where and how" of tarpon fishing in and around Mobile Bay. This is something that I personally have never accomplished and I look forward to hearing what he has to say. I hope to see a big crowd again this month.

Our guest speakers give up their time to come and share knowledge with our members, so please be courteous and keep the noise down as much as possible so your fellow members can hear clearly. We will continue to work on amplifying our sound to carry through the whole meeting area but until we have all the kinks worked out, I recommend anyone that has a difficult time hearing please try to arrive early to get a seat up towards the front.


