conditions. We had a full board in all the slam species (speck, redfish, flounder) with over 30 fish weighed in. We had two new anglers holding the top of the board. Alan Williams with a chunky 3.26 lb speck and George Dozier with a solid 1.92lb flounder. The



wind made getting out to the rigs for sheepshead difficult, but **Colton Carlisle** managed to bring in one to take the top spot at 3.71 lbs.



There were a large number of solid upper slot redfish brought in, with Mark Jones landing the biggest that made the slot at 5.89 lbs. Though many junior anglers fished their hardest, none managed to bring any fish to the scales. The full leaderboard can be found on here on the Fishing Chaos app. Remember, that leaderboard is

live, so you can see the real-time standings as soon as fish comes in no matter where you're at for all our tournaments. As far as food goes, Romie's chicken and sausage gumbo was a major hit and everyone took advantage of the nice afternoon to spend some time sitting around and talking fishing!
