The meeting got cranked up with news that the CPR contest has another new Black Drum record of 41 inches. This one by new angler Dustin Brooks. He and another new angler, Alan Williams have been having quite a back and forth contest of catching large drum from the Cedar Point Pier.

There was a good sized crowd on hand, as is always the case when Captain Bobby Abruscato (A-Team Fishing Adventures) is our guest speaker. Bobby, one of the founding members of the ACFA back in 1997, mentioned how great the history and traditions of the club are and how much he appreciates participating each year. His in-depth discussion was primarily focused on springtime wade fishing tactics for speckled trout. What to look for, where and when to look, how to gear up, along with the 'whys' and specific recommendations of tackle and tactics to catch trout on the beach. We also gave out a dozen new plaques along with even more plates, many going to Junior members. It was a great meeting all the way around!
